

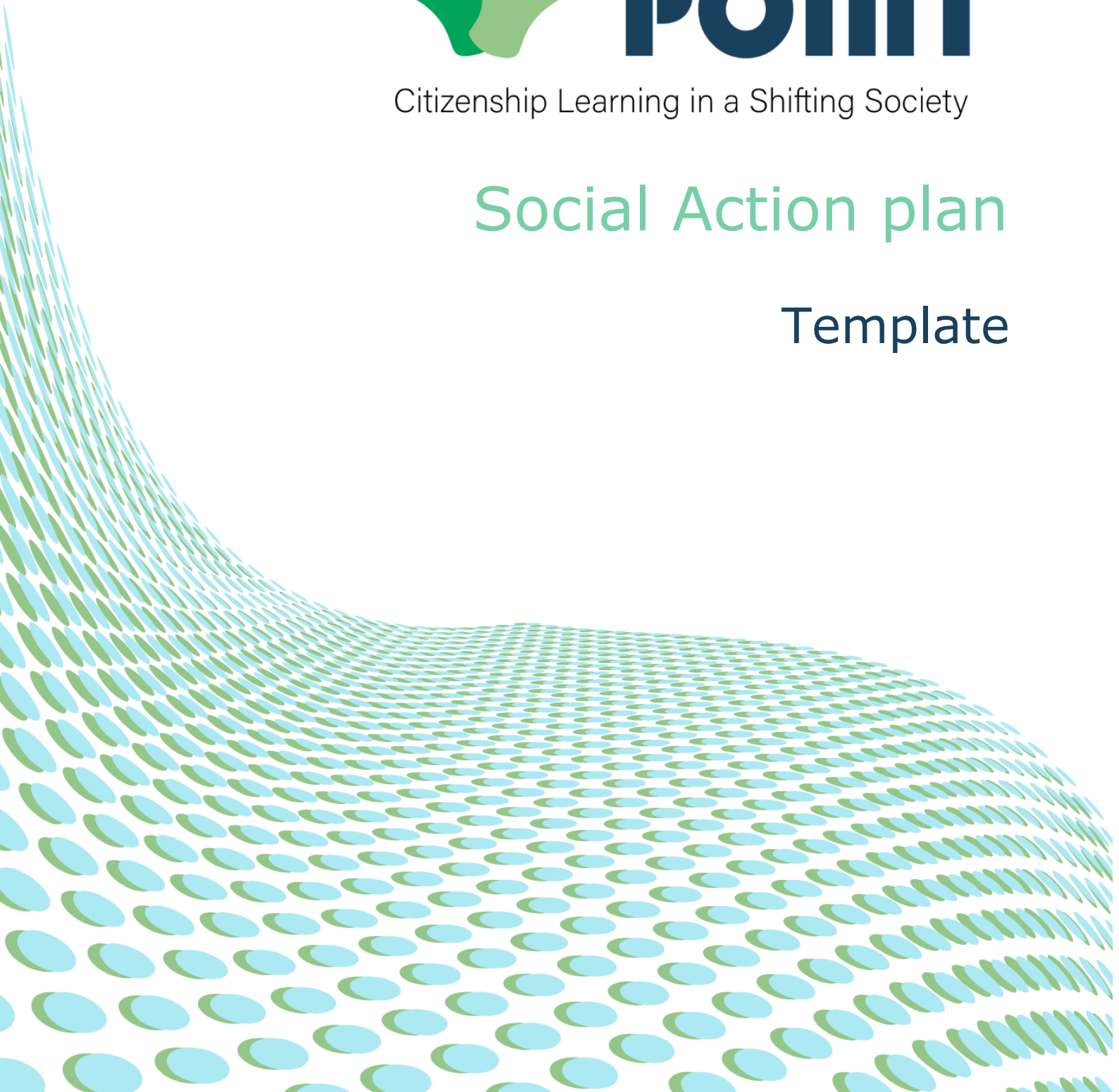

1. Define the problem

- a) Gather information using different investigative methods such as surveys, interviews, observation etc
- b) Recognize complexity
- c) State the problem : • clear, specific, inclusive, complex

2. Agree on a sound solution

- a) Generate possible solutions
- b) Short-list options
- c) Reach consensus:
 - Effective - Which option offers the best results for the greatest number of people?
 - Sustainable - Which option promises the most lasting effects?
 - Feasible - Which option is the most realistic given the available resources?
 - Respectful - Which option best respects the feelings and legitimate interests of stakeholders?

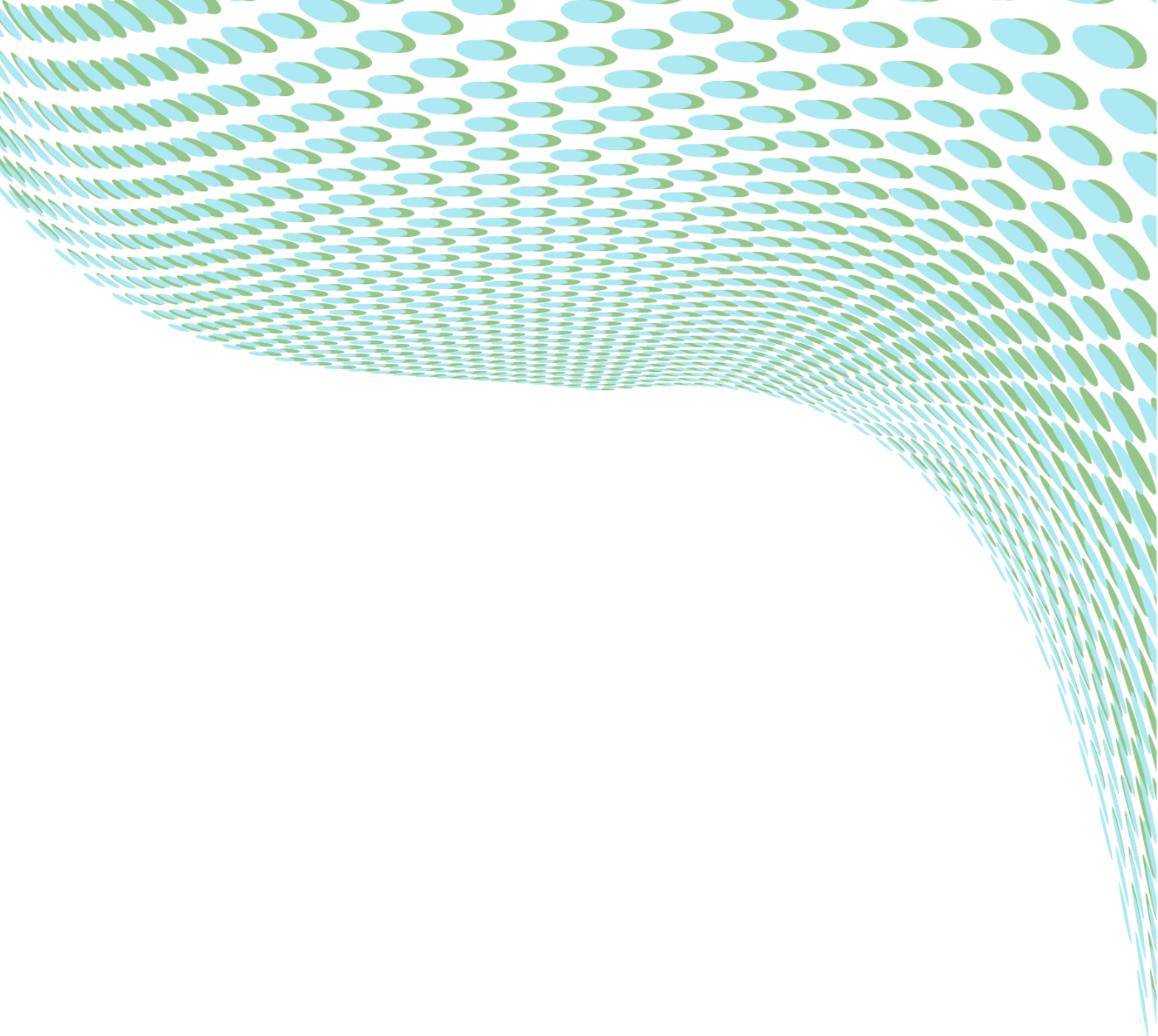
3. Plan an effective course of action

- a) Develop an action plan:
 - state specific goal and actions to be taken;
 - available resources—both intellectual and material—required to complete each step
 - person or persons responsible for carrying out each step
 - Timeline of the action
- b) Appraise the plan:
 - clear - Are the goals and tasks of the plan clear?
 - Effective - Are the proposed strategies likely to lead to the desired solution?
 - Respectful - Does the proposed action plan respect the interest of all stakeholders?
 - Realistic - Is the plan doable given our time and available resources?
 - Comprehensive - Does the plan contain and sequence the important tasks necessary for successful implementation?
